- Our reading story this week was called "Stan's Stunt". Before reading this story, we made predictions. Predications are a great way to begin reading. It helps set the mood for reading and grabs our interest so see if our prediction is right or wrong.
- This week in phonics we learned about initial and final blends. Blends are two letters that work together to form one sound. We worked on blends such as st, sk, and sp.
- These past couple of days, we've been learning about subtraction. This has been a hard adjustment since we are so used to addition. So far, we've worked on our facts of subtracting from 6. The hardest part of subtraction is having the kids understand that we start with a large group and then take away. Please work on their flashcards at home.
